# VACANCIES

We have 7 vacancies we are looking to fill. Two single apartments and five double occupancy spaces are available. Help us achieve maximum capacity of 22 residents. # FIRST FLOOR COMMON SPACE

Our Chapter House first floor includes a reception area, library & seating area, Chapter room, restrooms, TV monitors, Chapter recognition wall, computer/learning center and catering kitchen. This first floor common space is for our residents and non-resident Sigma Chi members and guests.

## **APARTMENT CONFIGURATIONS**

Fully furnished apartments are configured for either single or double occupancy. All apartments have an entry closet, refrigerator, kitchenette with cook top, microwave, sink with disposal, pantry closet and under counter trash bin plus touch pad locking safes.

All apartments have a 55" TV Monitor with wired access to internet service; individual heating and cooling mini split units with adjustable thermostat; private bathrooms with shower, wash basin, and toilet.

All single apartments include one full-size XL bed with mattress and headboard; under bed storage, sofa, clothes closet, larger desk with chair and 2 nightstands.

Double apartments have two twin-size XL beds with mattress and headboard; under bed storage, two 4-drawer chests, two clothes closets and two desks with chairs.

The first-floor laundry room is for use at no charge and has two clothes washers, two dryers, an ironing board and iron.

Below is a list of items we recommend that you bring to move in. Please coordinate with your roommate to avoid bringing duplicate items.

# WHAT to BRING

- Clothing items
- Laptop computer, study materials
- Power strip, printer, cables, alarm clock
- Sheets and bedding to fit the bed size noted previously
- Pillows with pillowcases
- Bathroom: towels, wash cloth, floor mat, shower caddy, small bathroom trash container, personal hygiene products, toilet paper, tissues
- Laundry: detergent, clothes basket/ bag, dryer sheets, clothes hangers
- Kitchen: plates, utensils, cups, drink glasses, paper towels, dish towels, saucepan, skillet, toaster, food storage containers, can opener, dish soap

- Apartment cleaning supplies for kitchen, bathroom, and floor cleaning.
   Trash container liners must be used.
- Area/throw rug
- Bicycles must be stored and locked using outdoor bike storage rack. No inside bike storage allowed.
- Room Decoration: Please use 3M
   Command adhesive
   strips and DO NOT drive
   nails, tacks, or other
   fasteners into our brand new apartment walls!

# REQUIRED CHECK-IN/ CHECK-OUT PROCEDURES

schedule an in-person and on-site check-in meeting with our Property Manager Representative from JNM Realty Group. Please schedule a time when both you and your roommate can be available. This check-in meeting is required to obtain access to the House and apartments. This will be a brief walk through the apartment followed by each resident signing a check-in form noting the contents and condition of the apartment.

CHECK-OUT: JNM Realty will conduct a check-out meeting with the same resident(s) in May 2024 to note damage or missing items that will be the responsibility of each resident.

# ALCOHOL/SUBSTANCE-FREE HOUSE

The House Corp and Active Chapter have signed a pledge with Sigma Chi International committing to the operation of an alcohol-free and substance-free Chapter House that includes its surrounding property. Our House Corp and Chapter insurance premiums for liability and property/casualty coverage are based on this commitment to an alcohol-free (dry) and substance-free Chapter House operation.
