## CHAPTER AND HOUSE CORP SIGN COMMITMENT STATEMENT FOR ALCOHOL & SUBSTANCE-FREE HOUSING

Our House Corporation and our Active Chapter officers have signed a Commitment Statement as requested by Sigma Chi Fraternity Risk Management Foundation (RMF) confirming that our Chapter House will be operated as an alcohol free or 'dry house'.

This pledge also includes any Chapter events hosted at a brother's residence, whether on or off campus. All Chapter events with alcohol must be held off-site (rented venue, bar, etc.) in conjunction with a licensed third-party vendor.

Making this Chapter-wide decision ensures that the Chapter can obtain affordable liability insurance coverage.

CHAPTER HOUSE SECURITY: Exterior doors, stairwells, parking areas and grounds are monitored by surveillance cameras. Our service provider, House Corporation and Independent Property Manager are authorized agents with exclusive control of any recorded video surveillance. Key fob is required for building entrance access. Cameras record both video and audio. Fire Sprinkler and monitored smoke alarm included.

## **KEY CHAPTER HOUSE FEATURES & TIPS**

RESIDENT AND ACTIVE MEMBER RESPONSIBILITIES: It is the responsibility of residents and non-resident members to do their part to keep this first class facility secure and clean at all times. Each apartment has a kitchenette complete with: refrigerator, microwave, cook top, garbage disposal, dish drying rack under-counter trash cans, and security safe.



#### **BICYCLE STORAGE**

Secure bicycle at the outdoor bike rack. No inside storage for bicycles.



Use 3M Command adhesive strips for wall decor. No nails, tacks, screws, or other adhesives are permitted!

#### COOKTOP (B)

Make sure cooktop controls are off when not in use. Do not ever place items on cooktop area.

#### MICROWAVE (C)

Bring microwave tolerant containers for use. Do not place metal or foil wrappers in microwave.

## DISH RACK (D)

Each resident is responsible to clean up after themselves. Stay ahead of dishes and cleaning.

#### GARBAGE DISPOSAL (E)

Garbage disposal is for small volume food waste. Keep water running while in use.



#### TRASH CONTAINER W/LINER (F)

Wednesday morning is trash pickup day. Each apartment resident is responsible for managing trash by always using a liner and getting filled trash bags to the portable bins. If your apartment will be unattended for an extended period, make sure to get your trash bags to the portable bins before leaving.



#### SECURITY SAFE (G)

Located inside closet. Secure your laptop and valuables for safe keeping. IMPORTANT! Test your access code BEFORE placing items inside to make sure the safe is operational.



Located on first floor. Get familiar with controls. The laundry facility is for resident use only. Promptly and completely remove laundry once finished so others may have access to the machines as well.





PARKING - One space per resident. Non-resident members and guests should not occupy spaces reserved for residents. Parking Lot 25 at NE corner of Madison and Holland is nearest campus lot for visitors.
