
BROTHERHOOD RETREAT OCTOBER 2025

Thanks to those 110 Alumni and friends who contributed to the Foundation for the Future of Eta Kappa Campaign!

As we bring our six-year alumni supported capital campaign to a close, our active brothers and alumni volunteers extend a sincere thank you for your commitment to a brighter future for Sigma Chi at Missouri State.

We launched the campaign in November of 2019 with the goal of generating \$1.5M to build a new chapter house. 110 individual donors, nine who contributed multiple times to both our charitable fund and house corporation, generated \$1,388,678 for the campaign. The result is a premiere three-story 11,900 sq. ft. fraternity house with first floor common use space and two floors of private apartments offering furnished living space for twenty-two residents.

Special recognition donations were made in memory of eleven Eta Kappa Brothers by having their name placed on a commemorative plaque adjacent to apartment living spaces.
